**Question # 1:**

**Question #1:** Sampling frequency, early discussions had indicated sampling frequency would be 1 per 250m<sup>3</sup> for SPLP leachate and contaminant analysis but in the tender document Section 02 51 19 part 3.6.2 - Quality Control, it states 1 per 1000m<sup>3</sup>. Is this correct? If this is the case, number of samples would be about 1/4 of expected.

**Response to Question #1:**

The sampling frequency for SPLP Leachate is correct as stated (1 per 1000m<sup>3</sup>).

**Question #2:**

**Question #2:** Also looking for clarification of the analyses that will be required on the leachate. It states in the Section 02 51 19 part 1.8 Performance Requirements that the pre-bid tests are PAH, PCB, Metals and Mercury but for the QC samples from the S/S process (same section part 3.6.2) test are PAH, PCB, Metals, Mercury, Tier 1 and Dioxin/Furan. Depending on the types of test needed, we may or may not have to purchase new equipment.

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**Response to Question #2:**

Section 02 51 19 paragraph 3.6.2 (table) should include Leachate for PCBs, PAHs, Metals, Mercury, and RBCA Tier 1. RBCA Tier 1 should be added to the performance requirements listed in Section 02 51 19 paragraph 1.8. Dioxin/furan testing is not required as part of this contract.
