1	<p>I would be interested in learning from your design team if the treatment technology process has been preselected. If not, what technology is being recommended (eg. UF, NF, activated carbon, coagulation, UV, etc.).</p> <p><i>Answer: The treatment process is fully described on the drawing and in the contract documents. The two acceptable equipment vendors are listed in the specification.</i></p>	No
2	<p>Is there an engineering consultant you are working with on the project? Can you send me water quality information and treatment requirements including flows to be treated and finished water quality targets to be met?</p> <p><i>Answer: The water quality and treatment requirements are fully described in the contract documents.</i></p>	No
3	<p>Are the sluice gates electric actuated or manual as both are in the spec.?</p> <p><i>Answer: Drawing C07-DWG-N-019, section A-A indicates that the sluice gate has an actuator which should be electrical operated.</i></p>	No
4	<p>By way of addendum will the Form of Quotation be revised to reflect the cost of each contract with a total for both?</p> <p><i>Answer: The tender documents have a cost form for each element which will provide a total for the entire cost of the project.</i></p>	No
5	<p>I would like to submit information for review for the water tight manhole frame and covers as well as the HDPE drainage pipe for acceptance before sending off pricing to the bidders.</p> <p><i>Answer: The tender documents provide sufficient information for the material selection and review of Bidder's preliminary selection is not considered during the tender process. The Bidder is allowed to submit a proposed alternative with his tender package.</i></p>	No
